1. General Fire Safety

2. Electrical

3. Housekeeping

- \_\_\_ a. Vegetation AND combustible debris too close to building, other structures (i.e. sheds) AND/OR LP gas tanks.
- \_\_\_ b. Excessive trash/rubbish accumulation inside buildings AND inadequate removal.
- \_\_\_ c. Excessive accumulation of combustible materials in gutters and drains.
- \_\_\_ d. Cooking appliances with an excessive accumulation of grease and dirt build up.
- \_\_\_ e. Excessive use of decorative materials affixed and/or hanging on walls and ceilings.
- \_\_\_ f. Ladder fuels present. Shrubbery AND weeds presents fire spread to tree canopy.

4. Wood Stove

- \_\_\_ a. Wood stove flue (chimney) needs repair AND/OR cleaning.
- \_\_\_ b. Wood stove ash stored too close (or inside) the home AND/OR stored in combustible containers.
- \_\_\_ c. Clearance around wood stove NOT adequate (at least 3' around).
- \_\_\_ d. Tight fitting fire screen not in place OR in need of repair.

5. Storage

- \_\_\_ a. Combustibles stored in furnace, electrical and other mechanical rooms, AND/OR under stairways.
- \_\_\_ b. Flammable and combustible liquids stored within building.

6. Construction

- a. Walls, ceiling, and/or floor need repair. Location: \_\_\_\_\_
- b. Penetrations through rated walls, ceiling and floor partitions.
- c. Railings on stairwells not installed OR in need of repair.

7. Fire Protection and Detections Systems
