BURNING REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED:

1. The White Mountain Apache Fire & Rescue Department must be contacted immediately prior to ignition of the material by calling (928) 338-4311.

Note: Fire Department personnel may tell you not to burn if extreme fire or weather conditions are present or forecasted.

2. An adult must be constant supervision of the fire at all times until the fire is completely extinguished. There must be sufficient water under pressure and/or authorized fire control tools on site of the burn.
3. Burning the following material is prohibited: garbage, petroleum products, plastics, rubber, poison ivy, inorganic pesticides, lead, batteries, mercury, arsenic compounds, pesticides, weed killers, asphalt shingles, tar paper, etc.
4. Materials shall be no less than 50 feet from any structure.
5. No fire shall be ignited during any air pollution emergency episode, which is in effect in the area of the burn or during periods when smoke can be expected to accumulate to the extent that it will significantly impair visibility.
6. This permit must be present at the burn side and presented to a fire officer or law enforcement officer upon demand.
